Dear Friends of the Trampoline Gymnastics' family,

After an intense season with five stops of the World Cup Series (Baku, Santarem, Coimbra, West Palm Beach, and Varna), 2023 will come to a brilliant end for Trampoline Gymnastics with a superb World Championships in Birmingham (GBR) during November.

Twelve years after, Birmingham will host our community once again, adding an exciting new event to our calendar, as the 1st Junior World Championships will take place on Sunday 19 November.

The road to 2024 Olympic Games is almost halfway for both gymnasts and judges, and the coming months will be crucial to determine who will be at the Bercy Accor Arena next August.

The 2023 World Cup series have finished, and the winners were announced either in West Palm Beach (USA) or in Varna (BUL). The prospects for the 2024 season, with six confirmed events (Baku, Aalkmar, Cottbus, Varna, Coimbra and Arosa) - all of them scheduled before the Olympic Games - are high.

This newsletter is providing you with some brief information regarding the upcoming events for our sport, also dealing with the new rules to be applied in the next Olympic cycle (2025-2028).

A.- 2023 World Cup series

The five stages of the 2023 World Cup series are now part of the history books of our sport. The quality of the performance was increasing during the whole season, augmenting the accuracy of exercises, and improving most of the scores obtained by the gymnasts.

B.- 2023 World Championships

Birmingham (GBR) will host the 37th World Championships in Trampoline Gymnastics. Acting as a 2024 Olympic Games qualifier event, the Utilita Arena will be the magnificent landscape of an intense battle between the leading figures in Trampoline, Tumbling and Double Minitrampoline.

A participation record is observed in TUM and DMT events, where Q2 competition phases will be run in all events. Moreover, up to eight NFs have registered gymnasts/pairs in the eight events, leading to a promising All-Around Team Final during the last day of official competition.

C.- 2023 World Age Group Competitions

As reported in Newsletter 28, the FIG Executive Committee adopted the following amendment to the Junior and WAGC Rules as follows:

2.1 At WAGC, no Q2 is organized. *The finalists will be selected from the ranking order after qualifications (Q1) are completed.*

Consequently, the rule of the competition groups' winners will not be applied for determining the eight finalists.

Besides, the rule 3.1 (requirement 3 for 11-12 age group) was clarified adding the following word:

One (1) element with 360° somersault rotation **AND**, at least, 360° of twist.

In 2023, the schedule for WAGC has been compressed to three days, so room enough to run the first Junior World Championships is ensured. Consequently, the programme for these educational competitions will be tight and demanding for all participants. D.- 2023 Junior World Championships

On Sunday 19 November our sport will enjoy its initial Junior World Championships. The structure of the event will be anchored in the results achieved at the WAGC 13-14 and 15-16 age groups.

The competition format of the Junior World Championships will be limited to an initial semifinal (same rules as Q2) in the eight events, with participation limited to 16 gymnasts/pairs.

These 16 gymnasts/pairs will be the same as the 8 finalists in each age group and event during WAGC. So, all finalists in the 13-14 and in the 15-16 age groups will get a ticket to participate at the Junior World Championships.

Given that WAGC rules allow to compose SYN pairs between gymnasts of ages that might fall outside from the junior age limits (13-16 years old), WAGC pairs composed by at least one gymnast who has not been born in 2007, 2008, 2009 or 2010 will not be considered for the qualification to the Junior World Championships.

During the semifinal, these 16 gymnasts/pairs will complete one voluntary exercise and the top eight will advance to the finals.

A maximum of two gymnasts and/or one pair from the same NF will qualify for the Finals.

D.- 2024 Olympic Games

With the first three qualifying events already completed, the Olympic Games qualification ranking list will be published immediately after the end of the 2023 World Championships, once the first tickets to Paris 2024 are granted to their respective NFs/NOCs (Criteria 1 of the OG qualifying system).

E.- 2025-2028 Code of Points

A new Olympic cycle will begin in 2025 and rules should be ready well in advance, allowing gymnasts, coaches, and judges to get ready for new challenges.

The TRA-TC released an initial proposal for the 2025-2028 Code of Points that was delivered to the National Federations via the FIG Intranet. All NFs have shared their valuable input and comments with the TC until the first week of October.

The next stage on this deliberation process will take place in Birmingham, during the TRA-TC round table scheduled during the morning of November 8.

A final version of the CoP will be sent by the TRA-TC to the FIG EC, so the executive body will approve the new rules during its meeting in February 2024. These rules will be published in July 2024 and will come into effect on 1st January 2025.

F.- 2028 Olympic Games

The Executive Board of the International Olympic Committee announced on 13 October that Trampoline Gymnastics will be part of the official Olympic program at the 2028 Olympic Games in Los Angeles (USA), leading to the eighth consecutive appearance of individual trampoline in the main stage of global sports events.
